SECTION A

Answer ONE only from questions 1a) and 1b)

1a) You have been asked to suggest sites in the South West region with literary connections for a day tour for a group in a coach or minibus who have been attending one of the South West's prestigious Literature/Literary Festivals.

- 1) On the map of the region (provided) mark the location of the Literature/Literary Festival plus four specific sites which could be visited during a day out from that location.
- 2) Write brief guiding background/introductory notes on:
 - i. Factual information about the Festival the group have been attending and
 - ii. Factual information about the four places you have indicated on your map and their literary links.

Remember to include dates and qualify references to specific people and works of literature.

OR

1b) Identify the four Cultural and Natural Sites in the South West Region inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list

- 1) On the map provided give the full title as inscribed on the World Heritage list and indicate the location of each of the four sites in the region.
- 2) Select one of the four sites for a half day visit and:
 - i. Write an outline programme for the visit in note form and
 - ii. Explain, in note form, the significance of what you have chosen to include in the programme.
- 3) Write brief guiding notes for an introduction.

*[Candidates please note: The UNESCO designation "Biosphere Reserve" is a separate category and such sites are **not** included on "Heritage and Natural World Heritage Site" list]*

2. Complete the two tasks i) and ii) which are on the topic of Anglican Cathedrals in the South West Region
- i) On the map of the South West Region mark the position of each Anglican Cathedral in the Region.
 - ii) Select **two** of these Cathedrals (**excluding Exeter Cathedral**) and, for each; list 10 points of factual information relating to specific people, historic events or architectural details.

3. Complete the two tasks i) and ii) listed below which are on the topic of specific visitor attractions in the South West Region.
- i) On the map of the South West Region mark the position of the following:
 - a. Stourhead
 - b. Clovelly
 - c. Tintagel
 - d. Chedworth Roman Villa
 - e. Tolpuddle
 - f. Battle of Sedgemoor Visitors' Centre
 - ii) Select **two** of these sites and list points of information for each covering the most important historical facts, the people who have been of significance and what visitors can see there.

The comments should cover location, background information, significance within the region and specific detail about what visitors can see and do. 5. Select **TWO** of the following and write biographical notes for a three minute presentation. Your answer must include an indication as to when the individual lived. Also make clear what connection(s) each had with the South West Region and how the region influenced their lives and/or how they or their work affected the region.

 - b) Francis Drake
 - c) Richard Trevithick
 - d) Thomas Gainsborough

6. Write brief notes for a three minute introduction to **TWO** of the following visitor attractions in the South West Region. The notes should specify the location, give a brief list of historical background information and detail specific objects/sections of special interest which can be found there. Remember to give dates and mention significant personalities.
(Do **not** list any points about practical matters.):
 - a) Holburne Museum
 - b) Eden Project
 - c) Tank Museum
 - d) The Dean Heritage Centre
