1a) A cruise ship company have asked you to suggest possible FULL DAY (8 hours starting from 9.00am) coach itineraries for cruise ships calling in at ports/harbours in our region. The nationality will be American and they are all reasonably fit. For each itinerary they would like you to include two main stops (coffee and lunch).

1b) On the map provided mark 4 ports/harbours where cruise ships have called in our region, and where coach itineraries can be planned from.

2) Choose ONE of these ports and plan a full day itinerary for the group to include:

- i) The main 2 destinations you will visit
- ii) Factual information on these places
- iii) The route you will take
- iv) The topics for your commentary on route, to include background information and places you pass
- v) Timings for the day to include coffee and lunch stops

2b) You have been approached by a small literary group with a 16-seater mini-bus. They would like you to devise a full-day literary tour to take in the life and works (to include film locations where appropriate) of ONE of the following authors:

- i. Daphne du Maurier
- ii. Rosamunde Pilcher
- iii. Thomas Hardy
- iv. Jane Austen

The group will be staying at a location centrally situated for the author you choose.

Your notes should include:

- i. Where the group will be staying
- ii. Brief outline of route and timings to include coffee and lunch stops
- iii. Factual information about places of interest associated with the author

- iv. Factual information about places associated with the works of the author,
to include film locations where appropriate
